It's early Sunday morning...In the shadows of the darkness of night just before the light of day we see her...She makes her way to the tomb... Changed by His Love and Healing she followed Jesus...She became a disciple. She gave her means to support His Work...and she worked alongside Him. It is because she remains there that she then has a sacred moment with the Risen Jesus. They talk and then He commissions her to go and tell the others the Good News. Mary Magdalene teaches us to stay with the sufferings in our lives AND Jesus will come to us to comfort, to remind us of His

Love...and then to tell us to do the same.

Mary Magdalene owed much, gave much, loved much. She is an example of a disciple whose life was poured out in response to God's extravagant grace...because of this Jesus speaks to her.

Jesus, our Savior, wants to speak to you this Easter!
